DAY 1: FLY TO LONDON

FRIDAY 19TH APRIL 2024

Board your overnight flight to London.

DAY 2: FLY TO ICELAND

SATURDAY 20TH APRIL 2024

Arrive in London at 9:10am. Board Iceland Air for Reykjavik.
Upon arrival, transfer to hotel, check in and overnight.



DAY 3: BORGARFJÖRDUR PRIVATE TOUR

SUNDAY 21ST APRIL 2024

After breakfast, Head for Hvalfjörður and follow the road along the scenic landscape of the fjord to reach the Borgarfjörður area, which is known as the "Home of the Sagas". Visit Reykholt where the 13th century author Snorri Sturluson lived and the splendid waterfalls Barnafoss and Hraunfossar where the water flows out from beneath a lava field into the river below.

Stop at Deildarhuguhver, Iceland's largest hot spring (in terms of water production per second). Overnight at Hotel

DAY 4: GOLDEN CIRCLE CLASSIC TOUR | MONDAY 22ND APRIL 2024

After breakfast at your hotel. Depart toward Þingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where the world's oldest parliament met for centuries on the shores of Iceland's largest lake. Visit Iceland's most unique tomato farm Fridheimar greenhouse. Discover one of the many benefits of geothermal energy: greenhouse horticulture. Visit an organic greenhouse where tomatoes grow throughout the year thanks to the geothermal resources of the region. In the afternoon, continue on to the geothermal fields of Geysir with bubbling mud pools and the highspouting Strokkur and Gullfoss waterfall, where thousands of tons of icy water thunder majestically down double ledges into a deep canyon. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 5: SOUTH COAST TOUR | TUESDAY 23RD APRIL 2024

Morning after breakfast, join this tour of South Iceland, experience the powerful beauty of Seljalandsfoss waterfall, where the Seljalandsá river, which originates under Eyjafjallajökull glacier, falls, as well as Skógafoss, one of the largest waterfalls in Iceland. Just outside the town of Vík í Mýrdal, visit the soaring basalt rock formation known as Reynisdrangar and the black sand beach of Reynisfjara. We will take a refreshing walk on the magnificent black sand of Reynisfjara beach with its basalt columns of all sizes and shapes. From here we have a great view as well of the rock pillars. Legend says that the pillars originated when two trolls dragged a three-masted ship to land unsuccessfully and when daylight broke, they became needles of rock.

DAY 5: NORTHERN LIGHTS HUNT | WEDNESDAY 24TH APRIL 2024

In the Evening, join our guided Northern Lights tour. Far from the glow of Reykjavik, hunt for the elusive Aurora Borealis. On this evening tour, you may be lucky enough to see them swirling and dancing across the sky changing endlessly their color, shape, and size.

Overnight at your hotel. Please note that the Northern Lights are a natural phenomenon and sightings, therefore, cannot be guaranteed. Duration: approx. 3 hours

DAY 6: JÖKULSÁRLÓN GLACIAL LAGOON. | THURSDAY 25TH APRIL 2024

Morning after breakfast, we cross the Skeiðarársandur outwash plains with lovely views of the largest glacier in Europe, the Vatnajökull Glacier. Once we have crossed this vast black desert, we reach Skaftafell National Park. We head further east to one of the probably most famous attractions of South Iceland, the spectacular Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon, where icebergs break down from the Vatnajökull glacier and float on the lake. Here we will take time to walk around and enjoy the breathtaking scenery and visit the beach where numerous icebergs have floated ashore, transforming the beach as it were covered in diamonds. Drive back to hotel for overnight.

DAY 7: BLUE LAGOON | FRIDAY 26TH APRIL 2024

After breakfast, head to the Blue Lagoon, one of Iceland's top tourist attraction. A visit to the Blue Lagoon promotes harmony between body, mind and spirit, enabling bathers to soak away life's daily stresses. The modern facilities have been developed into a wellness complex including saunas, a warm flowing waterfall, and in-water treatments and massages using the all-natural Blue Lagoon skin care products. Relaxing. Rejuvenating. Unforgettable. Enjoy a relaxing evening on your own.

DAY 8: FLY TO LONDON | SATURDAY 27TH APRIL 2024
